Selection Process

- A video message will be sent in WhatsApp group of students from sports head and coaches explaining concept plan of beyond bells.
- Then students will submit Beyond Bells form.
- If number of forms is less than sanctioned strength in any event, then that game will be removed from beyond bells list.
- Then trial will be conducted and planned number of students will be selected for that game.

Code of Conduct

- **Attendance:** If a student misses the scheduled days more than 2 continuously, then he/she may be disqualified from beyond bells.
- **Dress Code:** Students must wear appropriate sports attire and footwear as decided by trainer, school uniform, or designated team jerseys.
- **Safety Rules:** Protective gear (e.g., helmets, pads) must be worn for contact sports.

9. Preparation for Performing arts will be done in Beyond Bells. Preparation for Theme activities timing will be done in club periods of leadership club. Final rehearsal will be done in last period of working day (before performance day).

Evaluation

Each assembly will be judged by Principal, Administrator & a third person appointed by Principal (third person must be from other house of that assembly).

1. Out of 5, 10 & 20 marks as per the types of assembly (Exam, Regular, and Special) will be awarded by the judges.
2. Marks deduction process will be applied for repeated students. (One marks for 1 repetition, 2 marks for 2 repetition, and 3 marks for more repetitions in that assembly).
3. After compilation of each phase of exam, the best house will be rewarded based on their assembly marks obtained by the judges.
4. Principal Sir will announce the assembly result from the stage on the next assembly day.
